Hence, pain needs immediate and aggressive intervention. Chronic pain is of gradual onset, multi-factorial in origin, persists longer, does not serve any adaptive function, and is less amenable to therapies.

Although 'Pain Management' has become a well-known specialty in many of the developed countries, in India it is relatively new and is still in the evolving stage with no uniform guidelines. Pharmacotherapy and physiotherapy remains the two main arms of conservative management of painful conditions. Interventional pain management has gradually turned into a vital armamentarium for pain management, particularly when the conservative management remains unsuccessful.
