Commemoration of PoSH Act 2013 on Dec 9th 2021

The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, prohibition and redressal) Act 2013(PoSH 2013) was notified on Dec 9th 2013. To commemorate and to spread awareness on prevention of sexual harassment in the workplace, the Internal Complaints Committee(ICC) of the Institute organized a programme as per instruction from the Ministry of Women and Child development. As a chartered institute under the DST program of Gender Advancement for Transforming Institutions (GATI), SCTIMST prides itself on providing a safe environment for women to work in and to develop as a professional.

To increase awareness two posters were designed and printed by the ICC and put up both at the AMCHSS foyer, where employees and students passed to the administrative and academic offices, and the BMT Wing notice-boards. The names of all the members of the ICC and their email addresses were displayed on these posters.



On 3rd December, a poster competition on the following two themes was announced for the poster competition in English, Hindi and Malayalam

- 1. Gender Advancement for Transforming Institutions(GATI) ensuring gender equality is a Human fight, not a Woman's fight.
- 2. Safe workplace- an Institute's pride

By 7th December, a total of 23 posters were received from the staff and students of the Institute, from BMT Wing, Hospital wing and AMCHSS. These were given for evaluation to Dr. Bismi Gopalakrishnan, Advocate and Professor of Faculty of Law, University of Kerala. Dr.Bismi was also invited to deliver a talk on the theme: "Prevention of Sexual Harassment at the Workplace (PoSH Act 2013) Legal & Human Right Considerations"

On 9th December, prizes for the poster competition were declared and prizewinning posters were displayed at AMCHSS and BMT Wing.

A consolation prize was also given to the Hindi Cell of the Institute for giving a poster with a good message in Hindi. The cash Prize was sponsored by the Gender Advancement for Transforming Institutions (GATI) project of the DST, for which the nodal officer, is Dr.Jayashree RS, Scientist F, Division of Biophotonics and Imaging, who is a member of the ICC.


