#### 12. **Generic**

1. The Seller shall not assign the Contract in whole or part without obtaining the prior written consent of buyer.
2. The Seller shall not sub-contract the Contract in whole or part to any entity without obtaining the prior written consent of buyer.

#### 13. **Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC**

1	During the selection process, in case of more than one bidder is emerged as L1, the selection criteria will be as per the GEM terms and conditions.
2	The age limit of the contract security guards deployed should be 55 years, subject to the condition that 10% of the Security guards may be allowed upto the age of 60 years.
3	<b>Only Ex-service men are eligible to be deployed as security guards</b>
4	Educational qualification of the security personnel to be deployed should be 10 <sup>th</sup> standard pass or equivalency certificate issued by the appropriate authorities.
5	The deployment should be 51 male security guards and 3 female security guards

7	Required reliever staff may also be arranged by the service provider as per the needs of the Institute. The reliever pool should be duly verified and approved by the Security & Safety Officer of the Institute and reliever deployment should be made from this pool.
8	Proper uniform (minimum 2 sets) should be provided to the security staff appointed by the service provider. No separate payments will be made by SCTIMST for that. All the Security Guards should be in proper uniform while on duty.
9	Ceremonial dress should be provided to the Security personnel by the service provider for the functions on January 26 and August 15 at their own cost.
10	Required round the clock Supervisory Service may be provided by the service provider without financial commitment to the Institute (Principal Employer). Night checking supervisor may also be provided by the Service provider as per the requirement of the Institute
11	Onsite training should be arranged to the Security Guards by the service provider as per the needs of the Institute on a regular basis. The service provider shall ensure that all security staff deployed in the Institute is well trained in Fire Fighting (Extinguisher & Hydrant System).

12	There is no employer – employee relationship between the Institute and the personnel engaged/deployed by the contractor and as such any misconduct by them on information given by the Institute shall be dealt with the contractor and action taken. Further as and when their conduct and work are found to be unsatisfactory, such personnel are to be replaced with suitable hands immediately by the contractor as per the original tender conditions.
13	The service provider shall ensure that the staff posted by him/her will not have any claim in SCTIMST by way of job, salary increase or any other benefit and should acknowledge and communicate to the staff that they are the employees of the contractor and not of the SCTIMST
14	It shall be the responsibility of the Service Provider to ensure maintenance of proper discipline of the persons engaged / deployed by him
15	The Service Provider/ Contractor shall comply with the instructions provided by SCTIMST from time to time relating to the performance of the services, duties and obligations under this agreement. The services rendered by the Service Provider/ Contractor shall be subject to regular review by SCTIMST and its decision as to the quality thereof shall be final and absolute.
16	The Service Provider/Contractor & the workers deployed by them at the SCTIMST premises shall maintain confidentiality of any information in their possession during their working at SCTIMST & thereafter.
17	The Service Provider/ Contractor shall allow SCTIMST, its management, auditors, regulators and/or agents, the opportunity of inspecting, examining, auditing and /or taking copies of the SCTIMST records with the Service Provider/ Contractor.
18	If at any stage, it is revealed that the documents/certificates/testimonials submitted by the Service Provider/ Contractor are forged or have been manipulated, the work order issued to the Service Provider/ Contractor shall be cancelled and Security amount deposited with SCTIMST shall be forfeited without any claim whatsoever on SCTIMST and the Service Provider/Contractor shall be liable for action as appropriate under the relevant laws.
19	The bidder or tenderer should arrange Police verification of each security guard deputed for our Institute at its own cost and submit a Police verification Report obtained from the Police authorities in respect of each Security guard, before deputing to our company treating it as a mandatory requirement. This is applicable to reliever deployment also. If there is a replacement done, the Police Verification of the new deployment also be submitted mandatorily.
20	The service provider shall ensure every security staff deployed at the Institute is medically fit and should obtain Medical fitness certificate from each security guard and reliever security guards.
21	The service provider shall ensure that no personnel engaged / deployed by him will engage in any type of activities prejudicial to the interest of the Institute.
22	The Service Provider/ Contractor shall be liable for any unlawful activities by the workers deployed by him / them to SCTIMST under this tender
23	The Service Provider/Contractor shall maintain proper records about the attendance of their staff in the prescribed format as given in the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970 along with Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Rules, 1971 and would ensure that full staff strength is maintained. If due to any exigency, any worker is absent the Service Provider/ Contractor should take immediate steps to provide its substitute subject to the compliance of relevant Rules & regulations/laws/ Statute.
